We are in receipt of a letter dated June 22, 2010, from Mr. James Minor, which requested an amended schedule for completion of Ordering Provision Nos. 3.c and 3.d of the above-referenced Agreed Order. The letter also provided specific reasons for delays.

Based upon the reviewed information, we approve an amended schedule as requested. The new deadline for compliance with Ordering Provision Nos. 3.c and 3.d is September 23, 2011, provided interim progress reports are submitted by December 31, 2010 and April 30, 2011.
